

Current provisions (as of 10 December 2021)

Hotel:

- Access only possible with 2G proof (vaccinated or recovered)
- Children under 12 years of age are excluded from this provision
- FFP-2 masks are mandatory in public areas (except seat, wellness area, gym)

Restaurant:

- Access only possible with 2G proof (vaccinated or recovered)
- Children under 12 years of age are excluded from this provision
- FFP-2 masks are mandatory (except at the seat)
- Registration obligation (data protection is observed)

Skiing:

- Access only possible with 2G proof (vaccinated or recovered)
- Children under 12 years of age are excluded from this provision
- FFP-2 masks are mandatory in gondolas & chairlifts

Test options:

- Free PCR throat tests at food markets Spar and M-Preis
- Per Person these tests can be handed out 3 times a week
- Evaluation takes place within 24 hours

Possibility of vaccination:

- All guests can get vaccinated or boosted at the official vaccination routes of Tyrol
- The vaccination certificate is valid immediately after vaccination and is recognized

Covid-19-Regulations Children

- Children under the age of 12 are not required to be tested or vaccinated
- "Foreign" Children between 12 and 15 years of age can achieve a "2G status" with 3 tests per week (at least one PCR test)
- From the 15th birthday a 2G proof (vaccinated or recovered) is required

Entry requirements (as of 10 December 2021)

Belgium:

- No testing and quarantine obligation in Austria and Belgium with 2G proof
- Children under 12 years are exempted from testing and quarantine

Denmark:

- No testing and quarantine obligation when entering Denmark with 3G proof
- No testing and quarantine obligation in Austria with 2G proof
- Exception for children under 12 years

Germany:

- No quarantine obligation in Austria and Germany with 2G proof
- For children under 12 years (who do not have a 2G certificate), quarantine automatically ends after 5 days

United Kingdom:

- No testing and quarantine obligation in Austria with 2G proof
- When returning to the UK, even fully vaccinated individuals must take an antigen or PCR test in the last two days before arrival
- Exception for children under 12 years

Luxembourg:

- No testing and quarantine obligation when entering Luxembourg with 3G proof
- No testing and quarantine obligation in Austria with 2G proof
